

Save Thompson's Field



Barratt & David Wilson Homes last week submitted an outline planning application to build 54 properties on Greenfield land in Sutton, opposite the junction of Bridge Road & Holme Lane, known locally as Thompson's Field.

The field is regarded as a Green Wedge, separating the villages of Glusburn, Crosshills & Sutton and it is imperative that we fight this proposal.

If planning permission is approved on this site, it sets a precedent for any other planning applications submitted on Greenfield areas in the village. This could leave all Greenfield sites vulnerable and make it even more difficult for the council to refuse future applications.

Strong opposition is needed to prevent this development.
