Tumble Tots Centres in Keighley, Wilsden or
Skipton can tell you it is nothing of the sort.
Tumble Tots is an educational physical
development programme designed to
develop children's motor skills and build
their confidence and self-esteem. It covers all
ages from 6 months to 7 years in separate

groups. The programme has been established nationally for 28 years and was originally designed by an Olympic Gymnastics Coach to develop children's agility, balance and coordination during their formative years. At the same time it also develops selfconfidence, self discipline and a sense of identity. During each weekly session Tumble Tots will provide challenging and structured physical activities using brightly coloured specially designed equipment. Bars, trestles, ladders, balance boards, tunnels, hoops, balls and foam equipment are used to include all aspects of physical motor education designed to heighten a child's total body awareness. Action Songs an rhymes also help contribute to language development.


