Most Cricketers will be glad to seethe back of the 2007 season with many games being abandoned due to rain. Following promotion to the Craven League Division 1 in 2006 the 1st team also struggled to over-come the loss of several players, despite some good individual performances, failed to avoid a return to Division 2 next season.

1st Team Average Winners were: Batting: C Capstick 674 runs (Ave 39.7) Bowling: S Doane 29 wickets (Ave 28.2) The 2nd Team, playing in Division 5, was made up of mostly Under 15 junior players and put in some spirited performances, which should stand us in good stead for 2008.

2nd Team Average winners were: Batting: P Williams 279 runs (Ave 23.2) Bowling: D Holdsworth 38 wickets (Ave 9.3) The clubs 2 Junior teams (under 15 and 13 age groups) had a very good seasons. Most of the players also had their first experience of playing Senior Cricket, and have done very well. We hope to see all of the Junior players next

The Club has 3 players selected for the Junior League Under 13 representative side with Johnny Wilkinson also winning the Under 15 League batting award with a batting average of 80 runs.

The Club have been very busy during the summer, putting together a 5 year development plan and also starting the first steps towards achieving a recognised Cricket Club Standard accreditation.

We are hoping that in the long term this will not only strengthen the Club on the playing field but also lead to an improvement in our facilities, which have changed little since the 1930's. We also hosted a Kwik Cricket Festival of Primary Schools from Sutton in Craven, Kildwick, Glusburn, and Cowling. Our own Ben Bolland, a qualified coach, went to the schools and provided coaching ahead of the tournament. We also formalised our links with South Craven College who play games against other schools/ colleges at our Royd Hill ground.

At the Clubs AGM earlier in the year Clifford Gill was deservedly made a life President following 70 years of service with the Club.
