

Parish Council

Sutton in Craven Bowling Club are requesting permission from the Parish Council to allow the installation of flood lights around the Bowling Green in the Park. Funding for the project can then be sourced by the Bowling Club. The Club wishes to improve its recognition by hosting more competitions and to do this they require the Flood Lights. The cost of the Flood Lights, installation and the electric used will be completely borne by the Bowls Club. The lights would be required 2/3 nights per week in April May, September and October to extend the length of playing light, until no later than 10.00pm. Specialist Lighting reports have been submitted to the Council from the Bowls Club, showing the type of lights proposed and how the lights affect the parameters of the bowling green, both inside and out. The lighting proposed would be subject to full investigation by the Parish Council.

Residents who live directly opposite have been consulted by the Parish Council. The proposal was explained, plans shown and a letter left seeking their views. No objections were raised by any of the residents visited. The Park Keeper has agreed, should the proposal go ahead, that he is happy to monitor and lock up the Park on the allocated nights. On the rare occasion he may be absent, an appointed person will undertake the duty. The Pavilion would continue to remain open on those evenings at no extra staff costs. Public Liability is fully covered and a risk assessment would be undertaken. The Parish Council wish to consult the residents of the village on this matter. If you wish to express a view on the above proposal, please write to the Parish Council using the following address:
