The Three acts entertained ages from 8 to 80, I kid you not! This was an event not to be missed. Anne Drury, the first act, had an emotive and vibrant performance, and as a solo artist performing in only her third live performance held the audience in thrall with her command of the keyboard and her range and cadence of vocals. *We know the location and the year, and even
the make of the bus and its owner, but we don't
know where these men, all Dressed in their
Sunday finery, are setting off to on this fine day
in 1910. Joe Sutcliffe, landlord of the King's Arms
in Sutton, near Keighley, ran a self-help club from
the pub to help local workers if they were off
sick; so this is maybe members of that club off
on a day's outing to the coast or to a horse race
meeting. The bus, known as 'the Monster', was
the first one in Yorkshire, a Milnes-Daimler bought
five years earlier by a far-sighted entrepreneur
called Ezra Laycock from nearby Cowling.*
